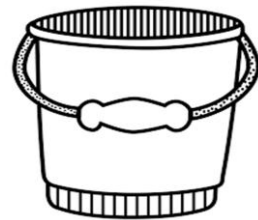

Articles (A, An)

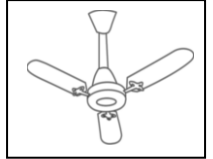
- We use 'A' before a singular noun beginning with consonant sound.
